Beef Show Schedule:

11AM: Open Show

4PM: Sizzlin' Summer Classic Jackpot

6PM: Cattle released

General Rules & Regulations:

- **All animals must be on the grounds by 9AM with judging to commence at 10AM.**
- **All exhibitors must purchase a gate admission pass upon arrival to the grounds.**
- **All trailers are to enter the grounds through the 2nd avenue gate.**
- **Classes will be split at the discretion of the beef committee.**
- **Entry deadline is Friday July 10, 2026. Late entries will be subject to double the entry fee and will be accepted until 9AM July 13, 2026.**

- **Entry fees must be paid in full before the show begins. Please make cheques payable to the Nipawin Exhibition Association.**
- **All exhibitors must hold a valid premises ID number and provide it on the entry form for entries to be accepted and cattle to enter the exhibition grounds. For your tracking purposes the Nipawin Exhibition Association Inc PID # SK629HJ1T**
- **All bulls over a year of age must be shown with a nose ring or humbug whenever out of their stall.**
- **Any unruly cattle may be asked to leave the ring &/or fair grounds at the discretion of the beef committee.**
- **Bedding will not be supplied. Please bring straw or shavings for your stall in the barn.**
- **Bedding must be removed from the barn and piled outside the building before leaving the grounds. Every exhibitor is responsible for cleaning their stall area.**
- **Power is supplied in the barn, however, it is limited so brining generators is recommended.**
- **Grounds are equipped with a washrack.**
- **Cattle must remain on the grounds until 6pm.**
- **Trailers are to be parked in the NW corner of the grounds, by the beef barn, watch for signs.**
- **Campsites are available on a first come, first serve basis free of charge. We ask that you do not run AC as it is too hard on the power grid.**
- **Nipawin Exhibition &/or its committee members are not liable for any injury, dismemberment, death, property damage or loss that occurs during the exhibition.**

Open Show Class List:

Entry Fee: \$20/Class

Prize Payout: 1st—\$60, 2nd—\$40, 3rd—\$20

Female Classes:

1: Current Year Heifer Calf—Female born in 2026, minimum 3 months old at time of judging.

2: Yearling Heifer—Female born between January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025.

3: 2 Year Old Cow/Calf Pair—Female born between January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024 with natural, current year calf at side.

4: Mature Cow/Calf Pair—Female born prior to January 1, 2024 with natural, current year calf at side.

Steer Classes:

5: Current Year Steer Calf—Steer born in 2026, minimum 3 months old at time of judging.

Bull Classes:

6: Current Year Bull Calf—Bull born in 2026, minimum 3 months old at time of judging.

7: Yearling Bull—Bull born between January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025.

8: 2 Year Old Bull—Bull born between January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024.

Premier Exhibitor:

*****NEW IN 2025!!*****

Entry Fee: Free

Prize Payout: \$300

All cattle shown in the open show, entered under the same exhibitor name, will be eligible to compete for the Premier Exhibitor award.

Each animal will be awarded points based on their placings in their respective open show classes which are as follows:

1st: 10 points

2nd: 9 points

3rd: 8 points

4th: 7 Points

5th: 6 Points

6th+: 5 Points

The exhibitor with the highest accumulation of points will be awarded the Premier Exhibitor prize payout.

Division champions and overall champions, will not be awarded any additional points.

NOTE: **The more head you bring, the better your odds of winning!!**

Classes:

SSC 1: Yearling Heifer



- **Open to all yearling heifers born between January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025.**
- **Classes will be split at the discretion of the beef committee**
- **Heifers competing in the jackpot MUST be entered and compete in the open show.**
- **The wild card draws will take place at the conclusion of the jackpot and will include every heifer entered, excluding the Grand & Reserve entries.**

Showmanship Sweepstakes:

Open to all exhibitors—based on age as of January 1, 2026.

Entry Fee: \$15/Entry

Classes:

S1: Little Buckaroos—Under 6 years old (Must be accompanied by a parent/guardian)

S2: Peewee— 6 to 8 years old

S3: Junior—9 to 12 years old

S4: Intermediate—13-15 years old

S5: Senior—16-21 years old

S5: Old Timers— 22+ years old

Prize Payout: 1st: \$30, 2nd: \$20

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
